ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER
No. 2009- 52

Whereas, A.R.S. § 25-351 requires the Superior Court in each county to adopt and implement an education program for the purpose of educating persons about the impacts that divorce, the restructuring of families and judicial involvement have on children.

Whereas, A.R.S. § 25-352 requires parties in an action for dissolution of marriage, legal separation or annulment that involves a natural or an adopted minor, unemancipated child who is common to the parties or in any paternity proceeding in which a party has requested that the court determine custody, specific parenting time or child support, that the court shall order the parties to complete an educational program.

Whereas, A.R.S. § 25-355 allows for each person who attends the educational program required by the court may be required to pay to the clerk of the superior court a fee not to exceed fifty dollars that covers the cost of the program. The fee may be deferred or waived.


Whereas, the Superior Court of the State of Arizona in and for the County of Pinal currently charges \$30.00 per person for the parent education fee.

Whereas, it is necessary to increase the Parent Education fee to cover the costs of the program.

IT IS ORDERED:

Increasing the Parent Education fee from \$30 to \$40 per person effective May 1, 2009.
