IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that BRANDI N. CLARK be, and she is hereby appointed to serve as Justice of the Peace Pro Tempore for Precinct No. 3 for a period commencing August 20, 2009 and ending December 31, 2009, subject to the approval of the Board of Supervisors.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, that BRANDI N. CLARK, pursuant to A.R.S Sec. 22-122 (D), having agreed to donate her time, shall serve without additional pay;

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that BRANDI N. CLARK be entitled to mileage reimbursement from her home in Casa Grande, Arizona, to any duly assigned work place in Pinal County, Arizona, at the duly authorized rate, also payable through the Justice Court's budget.

This appointment is at the pleasure and direction of the Presiding Judge of the Superior Court. Such appointment may be terminated without cause at any time by the Presiding Judge
