**NOW, THEREFORE**, pursuant to A.R.S. Sec. 22-121 (B),


**IT IS HEREBY ORDERED** that **RICHARD LA PAGLIA, JR.** be, and he is hereby reappointed to serve as Justice of the Peace Pro Tempore for Precinct No. 3 for a period commencing January 1, 2010 and ending December 31, 2010.

**IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** that **RICHARD LA PAGLIA, JR.** be compensated in accordance with state law; payable through the Justice of the Peace, Precinct No. 3, budget.

**IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** that **RICHARD LA PAGLIA, JR.** be entitled to mileage reimbursement from his home in Eloy, Arizona, to any duly assigned work place in Pinal County, Arizona, at the duly authorized rate, also payable through the Justice Court's budget.

This appointment is at the pleasure and direction of the Presiding Judge of the Superior Court. Such appointment may be terminated without cause at any time by the Presiding Judge.
