
Whereas the Presiding Judge has administrative authority over the Judicial Branch of government in Pinal County, including judicial assignments within the Superior Court;

Whereas the Criminal Presiding Judge has determined, based on the number of criminal matters involved, that additional judicial assistance is necessary to efficiently handle those criminal cases in which one or more judges on the criminal bench have been struck pursuant to Rule 10.2, *Ariz.R.Crim.P.*;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the Hon. Craig Raymond, Superior Court Judge *Pro Tempore* and Commissioner shall receive the reassignment of such criminal cases in the Superior Court, as shall be determined and ordered by the Presiding Criminal Judge, following a proper Rule 10.2 notice. The resulting criminal caseload shall not exceed approximately one quarter of a full-time criminal judicial assignment, as determined by the Criminal Presiding Judge.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED establishing a regular Law & Motion criminal calendar on Thursday at 1:30 p.m., in Division 301, before the Honorable Craig Raymond, which is effective immediately.
