**NOW, THEREFORE**, pursuant to A.R.S. § 22-506, 28-1553, and 22-121(B),

**IT IS HEREBY ORDERED** that the aforementioned Civil Traffic Hearing Officers, Small Claims Hearing Officers, and Justices of the Peace *Pro Tempore* are appointed or reappointed, upon the same terms and conditions of their existing

appointment, but said reappointment shall expire on December 31, 2011. Any initial appointments of Justices of the Peace *Pro Tempore* are not effective until approved by the Pinal County Board of Supervisors.
