ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER
NO. 2012- 15

In accordance with Article VI, Section 11 of the Arizona Constitution, the Presiding Judge exercises administrative supervision over the Superior Court and the Judges, including Justice Court Precincts, within their county have such other duties as provided by law or rule of the Supreme Court, and

WHEREAS, The Justices of the Peace voted to nominate Roger Valdez as Presiding Justice of the Peace at the meeting on June 19, 2012, subject to the approval of the Presiding Judge of Pinal County, pursuant to Supreme Court Administrative Order 2005-23C(1)(6) which provides that the Presiding Justice of the Peace be elected by vote of the Justices of the Peace of the county with the advice and consent of the Presiding Judge of the county, and

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED appointing Roger Valdez as Presiding Justice of the Peace in Pinal County, who shall serve at the pleasure of the Presiding Judge for a term of two years from January 1, 2013 to December 31, 2015, or until a successor Presiding Justice of the Peace is appointed.
