ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER

NO: 2013- 23

WHEREAS the Presiding Judge of Pinal County has administrative authority over the Judicial Branch of government in Pinal County;

WHEREAS the Pinal County Board of Supervisors approved a resolution on August 28, 2013, declaring a county holiday on the Friday following the fourth Thursday in November (the day after "Thanksgiving") and voted to transact business on the second Monday in October ("Columbus Day"), which applies to all county departments and offices, including county justice courts, but not the Superior Court in Pinal County, which is a department of state government;

WHEREAS the Presiding Judge has authority to make the same election of holidays for the Superior Court in Pinal County, pursuant to A.R.S. § 12-127.

NOW, THEREFORE,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the Pinal County Superior Court, including Judicial Divisions, Adult Probation, Juvenile Probation, Clerk of the Court, and all other employees of the Superior Court, shall not conduct business on the Friday following the fourth Thursday in November (the day after "Thanksgiving"), except for necessary court functions that are routinely staffed on holidays, but shall transact business on the second Monday in October ("Columbus Day").

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that all supervisors and managers of the Judicial Branch of government in Pinal County shall accommodate all reasonable requests of judicial employees to seek approval or modification of vacation schedules that are directly impacted by this holiday election in 2013.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this holiday election is effective immediately and shall remain in effect unless modified by future order of the Presiding Judge; this order automatically expires if the Pinal County Board of Supervisors prospectively rescinds the underlying holiday schedule for county departments and offices.
