WHEREAS, it is necessary that Court Investigators, for the purpose of conducting investigations under Arizona Revised Statutes Title 14, Chapter 5, sections 5303 and 5307 may need to be appointed by the court;

WHEREAS such investigators are appointed for the purpose of providing the court with a report on the circumstances of the proposed Ward and the conditions and circumstances surrounding the proposed Ward; pursuant to Arizona Revised Statutes Title 14, Chapter 5, sections 5303 and 5307;

WHEREAS, Court Investigators appointed under this rule shall have a combination of education and work experience and have adhered to the requirements of Arizona Revised Statutes Title 14, section 5308 to qualify them to conduct the investigations;

NOW, THEREFORE IT IS HEREBY ORDERED: only individuals who have adhered to these requirements will be appointed by the court. These appointments are at the pleasure and

1 direction of the Presiding Judge and subject to annual reappointment. Such appointment or
2 reappointment may be terminated with or without cause at any time by the Presiding Judge.

3 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that all court investigators are to be paid at a rate
4 determined by the Presiding Judge.

6 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that all Court Investigators will submit reports on the
7 approved form, maintained by Court Administration.
