
NOW, THEREFORE pursuant to A.R.S. § 22-121(B),

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that **CHARLES ADORNETTO** and **MICHELLE K. O'HAIR-SHATTENBERG** be compensated in accordance with state law; payable through funds budgeted in the Judicial Branch and/or the Justices of the Peace for such purposes.

This appointment is at the pleasure and direction of the Presiding Judge of the Superior Court. Such appointment may be terminated without cause at any time by the Presiding Judge.
