ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER
No. 2016-00 44

Whereas the Presiding Judge has general administrative authority over the Judicial Branch of government in Pinal County, and the Presiding Judge has previously adopted Administrative Order 2016-0007 for the purpose of establishing and modifying policies and procedures for Court-Appointed Counsel and Providers of Related Services;

Whereas the Presiding Judge has voluntarily directed the Selection Committee to comply with the *Open Meeting Law*, pursuant to § 1.3 of AO 2016-0007, but the Presiding Judge finds that clarification of this direction is necessary;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that compliance with the *Open Meeting Law* is required only to the extent practical and consistent with the purpose and objectives of AO 2016-0007, and sole discretion is vested in the Selection Committee to determine the extent that such compliance is practical and consistent with the Administrative Order, except that discussion of the selection, elimination, or appointment of attorneys and providers of related services shall be interpreted to fall within the purpose of A.R.S. § 38-431.03(A)(1); notice of meetings is only required to be posted in the Pinal County Superior Courthouse; and the remainder of A.R.S. § 38-431.03(A)(1) shall not apply after the term "public body".
