ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER

WHEREAS, the Presiding Judge of the Superior Court of Arizona in and for Pinal County is the Chief Judicial Executive Officer of the County and has administrative supervision over all courts in Pinal County pursuant to Article VI of the Arizona Constitution and Arizona Supreme Court Administrative Order No. 2005-32 (revised May 16, 2005);

WHEREAS, the Presiding Judge has previously adopted Administrative Order 2016-0007 for the purpose of establishing and modifying policies and procedures for Court-Appointed Counsel and Providers of Related Services;

WHEREAS, the efficient processing of Juvenile Dependency and Severance cases requires the early assignment of court case numbers by the Clerk of the Court; so judicial staff can appropriately assign Court-Appointed Counsel and schedule time-sensitive initial hearings;

WHEREAS, the Presiding Judge, has determined that the Clerk of the Court and Juvenile Court Services have developed a more efficient process to ensure accurate and timely case assignment than ordered in 2016-00081;

Good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, that Administrative Order **2016 - 00081** be rescinded at this time.
