**WHEREAS** the Presiding Judge of the Superior Court of Arizona in and for Pinal County is the chief judicial officer of the county and has administrative authority over all the courts in Pinal County, pursuant to Article VI of the Arizona Constitution and Arizona Supreme Court Administrative Order No. 2005-32 (revised May 16, 2005); and,

**WHEREAS** the Honorable Larry Bravo, Justice of the Peace, Precinct No. 6 has requested the appointment of Albert Valtierra, and

**WHEREAS** the Presiding Judge finds that the afore-listed request for appointment is necessary, appropriate and in the best interest of the Judicial Branch of Government in Pinal County;

**NOW, THEREFORE** pursuant to A.R.S. § 22-121(B),

**IT IS HEREBY ORDERED**, that **Albert Valtierra** be and he is hereby appointed to serve as Justice of the Peace *Pro Tempore*, for a period commencing August 16, 2017 and ending December 31, 2017.

**IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** that **Albert Valtierra** be compensated in accordance with state law, payable through funds budgeted in the Judicial Branch and/or the Justices of the Peace for such purposes; and,

This appointment is at the pleasure and direction of the Presiding Judge of the Superior Court. Such appointment may be terminated without cause at any time by the Presiding Judge.
