**WHEREAS**, the Presiding Judge of the Superior Court of Arizona in and for Pinal County is the Chief Judicial Executive Officer of the County and has administrative supervision over all courts in Pinal County pursuant to Article VI of the Arizona Constitution and Arizona Supreme Court Administrative Order No. 2017-79; and

**WHEREAS**, the Presiding Judge exercises administrative supervision over the Superior Court, including the Clerk of the Superior Court, juvenile court as a division of the Superior Court, the justice of the peace courts and the municipal courts of Pinal County including all off their divisions, judges and judicial officers and employees; and

**WHEREAS**, on January 13, 2010, the Code of Conduct for Judicial Employees was updated and adopted by the Supreme Court of Arizona and contains strict guidelines for political activity in the courts (Canon 4 and Rules 4.1 – 4.8); and

**WHEREAS**, Arizona Supreme Court Administrative Order No. 2010-13 supersedes Pinal County Superior Court Administrative Order No. 2009-0057;

Good cause appearing,

**IT IS HEREBY ORDERED**, that Administrative Order No. 2009-0057 be rescinded at this time.
