WHEREAS the Presiding Judge of the Superior Court of Arizona in and for Pinal County is the chief judicial officer of the county and has administrative authority over all the courts in Pinal County, pursuant to Article VI of the Arizona Constitution and Arizona Supreme Court Administrative Order No. 2017-79; and,

WHEREAS the Honorable Nancy Discher, Justice of the Peace, Precinct No. 5 has requested the appointment of Darenday Day and Maria Rollins, and

WHEREAS the Presiding Judge finds that the afore-listed request for appointment is necessary, appropriate and in the best interest of the Judicial Branch of Government in Pinal County;

NOW, THEREFORE pursuant to A.R.S. § 22-121(B),

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, that **Darenday Day** and **Maria Rollins** are hereby appointed to serve as Justice of the Peace *Pro Tempore*, for a period commencing June 1, 2019 and ending December 31, 2019.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that **Darenday Day** and **Maria Rollins** be compensated in accordance with state law, payable through funds budgeted in the Judicial Branch and/or the Justices of the Peace for such purposes; and,

While serving in the capacity of Justice of the Peace *Pro Tempore*, Darenday Day and/or Maria Rollins will suspend her activities as the Judicial Office Manager/Supervisor for the Copper Corridor Justice Court. In accordance with Pinal County Human Resources requirement for proper time coding, separate time sheets will be submitted detailing the number of hours worked in each capacity. Use of vacation accruals, working an alternate schedule, or working hours outside of normal hours of operation for the Court (8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.) will not be permitted as a way to recover time lost in her primary duties.

This appointment is at the pleasure and direction of the Presiding Judge of the Superior Court. Such appointment may be terminated without cause at any time by the Presiding Judge.
