WHEREAS, it is necessary that one or more Special Masters, for the purpose of conducting initial appearances under Criminal Rule 4, may be appointed by the presiding judge of the Superior Court in each county for the purpose of enhancing the ability of the various Pinal County Justice Courts to process cases; now therefore, pursuant to Criminal Rule 1.7,

WHEREAS, compensation of Special Masters under the rule shall be set by the presiding judge; and

WHEREAS, Special Masters appointed under this rule shall have a combination of education and work experience that, in the opinion of the presiding judge, qualifies them to conduct initial appearances; and

WHEREAS, the Presiding Judge finds that the following appointment is necessary, appropriate and in the best interest of the Judicial Branch of Government in Pinal County:

Eustino Tarango

NOW, THEREFORE IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, appointing the aforementioned Eustino Tarango as a Special Master for Pinal County effective June 6, 2019 for a term ending December 31, 2019. This appointment is at the pleasure and direction of the presiding judge of the superior court and subject to annual reappointment. Such appointment may be terminated without cause at any time by the presiding judge.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Special Masters are to be paid at the rate of \$50.00 per hour or a flat fee for each weekend or holiday, as determined by the Presiding Judge. The Special Master is a temporary, part-time employee of the County and compensation is subject to withholding as required by Federal and State law.
