ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER

Pursuant to the Constitution of the State of Arizona, Article 6, Section 24, A.R.S. §12-213, as amended, and the Rules of the Arizona Supreme Court (RASC),

IT IS ORDERED that Matthew S. Reed is hereby appointed as a Court Commissioner of the Arizona Superior Court in Pinal County, on a full time basis, commencing September 20, 2020 and ending June 30, 2021, subject to annual reappointment by the Presiding Judge.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Matthew S. Reed shall have all such powers and duties pursuant to law which shall include, but not limited to, those powers and duties prescribed by A.R.S. §12-213, as amended, and Rule 96, RASC, as amended.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Matthew S. Reed shall be compensated according to the A.R.S. §12-213(B) and the existing compensation plan for a Commissioner of the Arizona Superior Court in Pinal County, and

This appointment is conditioned upon the agreement to serve only for the compensation received as a Court Commissioner while employed as a Commissioner by the Court, and to receive no additional compensation or benefit, fiscal or otherwise, when acting in the capacity of a Judge Pro Tempore.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Matthew S. Reed is assigned to hear and decide matters assigned to him by the Presiding Judge, or designee, without further written order.
